

# Excluding criteria from your search

**Within certain filters, you have the option to exclude criteria from your search**

Add filters to your search in order to narrow down your results. You can also exclude criteria by hovering over the selection and clicking *Exclude*. This could be useful if you don't want to view results for a particular species (like in the example below, excluding *Human* from **Reactivity**), or if you want to exclude seeing products from a particular vendor.

Simply hover over a selection when you open a filter to click *Exclude* to remove specs from your search. Once you apply this, you will see it added to the search bar.
